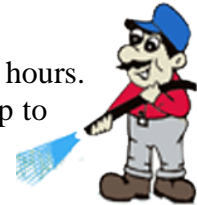


Thank you for choosing Washington Green Hydroseeding, Inc. as your Hydroseed specialist. Please read the following instructions for the care of you new lawn.

Watering:

0 - 4 Weeks: Ensure that the Hydroseed is kept moist all day during daylight hours. Keep in mind that during the hotter summer months you may have to water up to six times a day to maintain the proper moisture content. The best practice is to water light and frequently using as many minutes as possible per station without creating runoff. Until your root system is completely mature, avoid night watering.



4 - 8 Weeks: Reduce the frequency of the water cycle about every 10 days while increasing the time to the maximum amount without allowing water to pool.

8 Weeks: After your lawn is established, reduce the watering cycles to once a day or once every other day depending on the season. Once the lawn is mature, longer deeper watering promotes a deeper root system and is much better than shallow frequent watering. Watch for signs of fungus and pests and treat accordingly. If these conditions exist consult a lawn care professional or the experts at the Cooperative Extension office in your area for free advice. Fertilizer:

Fertilizer is a very important component in your lawn care. Due to the frequency of watering, the nutrients needed by the lawn are being washed away. Therefore it is recommended that you replenish these nutrients by using 4 pounds of fertilizer per 1000 square feet of area. We recommend using 16-16-16 however you may want to consult a local lawn care professional to implement a program to fit your needs. The following easy to remember dates are recommended times for adding fertilizer.

Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, & Halloween

After 5 – 6 weeks you may also implement a weed control program. You may want to contact a local lawn care professional to determine the best products for your area.

The workmanship and materials used to complete your new hydroseeded lawn are guaranteed provided you follow these instructions for the care of your new lawn. The warranty does not cover areas that suffer due to lack of water or displacement of the Hydroseed due to any manual disturbance, erosion, high winds and other natural causes.
